### 主席的話

正值香港突破機構慶祝 50 年來培育青少年的不斷耕耘,突破海外使團有 機會於 10 月 14 日在多倫多舉行了一次異象分享餐會,由突破總幹事及副 總幹事們分享對突破運動的委身和遠象,並報告了在重重困難中仍繼續開 展新的事工模式。這次聚會樂見跨代的突破人濟濟一堂 — 早期和近期同 工,長期義工,以及忠心的支持者,更開心有扶長攜幼出席的。這聚會反 映了對突破運動廣闊而有力的支持,蒙聖靈的激勵,令大家對突破前景更 存殷盼。感謝上主!



2023 年是突破 50 周年紀念的日子,面對疫情、離散及社會持續急劇轉動的衝擊,我們選擇「憑信堅立向前」作主題,回應時代的呼喊。在今年 10 月,總幹事 Joyce 率領團隊 Jeffrey, Pakkin, Wilson 及 Janet 到 北美數個城市,與突破海外同行者慶祝突破 50 周年,並分享未來事工 重點。

團隊齊集加拿大多倫多3天,與突破海外使團董事開會,匯報突破近 況;到訪不同華人教會,交流在近年大量香港青年移居當地的背景下, 青少年事工的挑戰與機遇;約見伙伴團體,探索未來事工發展及合作 可能;接觸突破輔導、影音及出版第一代同工義工,細聽當年「將火種撒 在地上」的故事…

多倫多之行重點活動是「突破 50 周年異象分享」午宴,當天共百多位海外同行者出席,擠滿整個場地。 其中有 50 年來一直支持突破的「舊友」,亦有剛到多倫多不久的「新知」一突破青年受眾。Joyce 回 顧 50 年來神怎樣透過祂忠心的僕人恩佩、蔡醫、永泰等,讓突破與香港青少年同行,陪伴他們成長; Pakkin 與 Wilson 分享他們被呼召入突破的見證,並媒體及人際事工如何在此時此刻服侍香港青年人; Jeffrey 及 Janet 則帶領所有與會者透過叠高不同形狀的人型積木,寓意青年人仍能透過群體支持「憑 信堅立向前」。

多倫多之行後,團隊便分成小隊或個人,到溫哥華、卡加 利及美國灣區等地,繼續探訪當地的同行者。回望是次 旅程,無論是禱告或是金錢上的支持,實感受到海外同 行者對突破的厚愛,但願「我們又藉著他,因信得進入現 在所站的這恩典中,並且歡歡喜喜盼望神的榮耀」。





五十年前,從城中傳來低調的吶喊,蘇恩佩姊妹、蔡元雲醫生與一群基 督徒,當中包括梁永泰博士,於是一起禱告思索當下青年人的需要,而 社會又需要怎麼樣的土壤,可以讓年輕的生命在破土中成長呢?

在同工身上,我看到在黑暗中,他們怎樣燃點自己,用生命照亮青年人的 生命。此刻,世局風起雲湧,周遭充滿負面的訊息,年輕人要健康成長 實在充滿挑戰。我想,每一代大概都有他要背負的十字架吧,而作為一 個被召服青少年的群體,豈不就是為「亂世」而生,為要分享那從上而來 的愛與平安?

感謝突破海外使團 Breakthrough Overseas Mission 和 加拿大的朋友,多年來關心香港青少年,這顆心並沒有隨 着時間褪色,情誼亦未因地域而中斷,讓我深深感受到上 帝無盡的恩典,也因此堅定相信,「突破」的故事將會延 續下去!

### Message from Board Chair

> What a cross-generational gathering! On Oct 14th, as the Breakthrough movement celebrates its 50th anniversary this year, Breakthrough Overseas Missions organized a luncheon in Toronto at which Breakthrough staff team from Hong Kong, General Secretary and Associate General Secretaries, shared their passion and vision for Breakthrough ministry and how they continue to break new grounds for the way forward. The gathering brought together old-timers as well as those new to Canada - former staff, longtime volunteers and faithful supporters. It is encouraging to see even some children. The good spirit at this event highlighted broad support and strong hope for the future of the Breakthrough movement! Thanks be to God!



2023 marks the 50th anniversary of Breakthrough. Faced with the impact of the epidemic, separation and the continuous rapid changes in society, we chose "Here We Stand" as the theme to respond to the call of the times. In October this year, our General Secretary Joyce, together with the team Jeffrey, Pakkin, Wilson and Janet, traveled to several North American cities to celebrate the 50th anniversary of Breakthrough and to share our ministry highlights with overseas supporters.

The team gathered in Toronto, Canada, for three days to hold meetings with the directors of Breakthrough Overseas Mission to report on the current status of Breakthrough; visited different Chinese churches and exchanged views on the challenges and opportunities of youth ministry in the context

of a large number of young people from Hong Kong immigrating there in recent years; met with partner groups to explore future ministry development and cooperation possibilities; contacted the first-generation co-workers and volunteers of Breakthrough and listened to their stories of " bring fire on the earth "...

The key event of the trip to Toronto was the "Breakthrough 50th Anniversary Vision Sharing" luncheon. Over hundred overseas supporters attended. Among them were "old friends" who had been supporting breakthroughs for 50 years, and there were also "new ones"-young people who have just arrived in Toronto. Joyce reviewed how God, through His loyal servants Josephine, Dr. Choi, Wing Tai and others, had guided Breakthrough to walk with the young people in Hong Kong over the past 50 years; Pakkin and Wilson shared their testimonies of being called to



Breakthrough, as well as how media and interpersonal ministry could serve the youth in Hong Kong at this particular moment; Jeffrey and Janet led all participants to stack human-shaped building blocks of different shapes, implying that young people could still face the future through group support -"Here We Stand".

After the trip to Toronto, the team divided into small groups or individuals and went to Vancouver, Calgary, and the Bay Area of the United States to visit our supporters there. We were deeply moved by the great love of our overseas supporters for Breakthrough, whether it was prayers or financial support. We hope "through God we have gained access by faith into this grace in which we now stand. And we boast in the hope of the glory of God.'



Fifty years ago, there was a discreet cry in the city. Josephine So, Dr Philemon Choi and a group of Christians, including Dr Wingtai Leung, gathered to pray and contemplate the yearnings of young people in Hong Kong, as well as what kind of environment is needed to allow young lives to grow amidst the brokenness of our time.

Looking back, I am blessed to witness how co-workers use their lives to illuminate the lives of young people and to ignite hopes in the darkness. While the world is surrounded by wars, negative news and bad vibes, it is truly challenging for the next generation to experience healthy wholistic growth. I think perhaps every generation has its own cross to bear, and as a

group being called to serve, it is indeed our mission to share love and the Good News during this chaotic time.

I am grateful to Breakthrough Overseas Mission and friends in Canada for your cares and support over the years. By God's grace, your love for young people in Hong Kong has not faded with time, and our friendship has been kept anew despite of the distance. All these help us to reaffirm our commitment to His Call, and that the story of "Breakthrough" will continue!
